JOURNAL ENTRY

On the 19th day of November, 1999, the above matter came before the Court on Respondent Claudine Dombrowski's Objection to Case Manager Recommendations made on October 28, 1999. Petitioner Halleck Richardson appeared in person and with counsel, Donald R. Hoffman. Respondent Claudine Dombrowski appeared in person and with counsel, Rebecca A. King.

After hearing the statements of counsel and evidence, the Court made the following findings:

1. Respondent Claudine Dombrowski's Objection to Case Manager Recommendations is denied.

2. The Case Manager's Recommendations of October 28, 1999 are adopted and modified as follows:

(a) Supervised visitation by Francessca Montes will continue through Saturday, November 20, 1999 and shall thereafter be terminated.

(b) Mr. Richardson's unsupervised visitation with Rikki shall begin on November 27, 1999, at 9:00 a.m. and

continue until 3:00 p.m. Thereafter, Mr. Richardson shall have unsupervised visitation each Saturday from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Beginning Wednesday, January 5, 2000, Mr. Richardson's visitation shall expand to include January 5, 2000 from 5:00 p.m. through 8:00 p.m. Thereafter, in addition to visitations each Saturday, Mr. Richardson shall have visitation with Rikki each Wednesday from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. Ms. Dombrowski shall drop off Rikki at 8:45 a.m. and pick up Rikki at 3:15 p.m. for the Saturday visits. Ms. Dombrowski shall drop off Rikki at 4:45 p.m. and pick up Rikki at 8:15 p.m. for the Wednesday visits.

(c) Because Christmas and New Years holidays will be on Saturdays in 1999 and the YMCA Safe Visit Program will be closed on those days, Mr. Richardson's visitation for those days will be Friday, December 24, 1999 from 9:00 a.m. through 3:00 p.m. and Friday, December 31, 1999 from 9:00 a.m. through 3:00 p.m. Ms. Dombrowski shall drop off Rikki at 8:45 a.m. and pick up Rikki at 3:15 p.m. on those visitation days.

(d) The visitation exchanges of Rikki shall be monitored through the YMCA Safe Visit Program, 2036 N.W. Taylor, Topeka, KS 66608, tele. 785-234-4677. Costs of the visitation shall be divided equally. The parties are ordered to contact the Safe Visit Program within 2 days from the date of this Order to make arrangements for the visitation. The visitation schedule is subject to rules, regulations and the availability of the YMCA Safe Visit Program and personnel.

3. The parties are directed to exchange earnings information and to determine whether the current child support is appropriate. The parties may seek modification of child support as may be appropriate by filing a Motion and supporting documentation with this Court.
